DIRECTIONS:

**HAMILTON ELKS GOLF COURSE (Sign displays Elks Golf Club)
ROUTE 4 – HAMILTON (4444 Hamilton-Middletown Rd)**

From I-75 North – Drive south, exit Rt. 63 (Monroe) and turn right (west) and go 4.5 miles to State Route 4 south and 3 miles to golf course entrance on right.

From I-75 South – Driving north, exit State Route 129 (Fox Highway) west and go 4.5 miles to SR 747 (Princeton-Glendale Road). Turn right (north) and go 3 miles to Route 4. Turn left on Rt. 4 and go 1.3 miles to golf course with entrance on right.

From Route 4 Hamilton – Drive north-east on Rt. 4 approx. 6 miles from city of Hamilton (corner of High & Main streets). The golf course is on the left a quarter mile past the Kroger's (corner of Rt. 4 & Liberty-Fairfield Rd.) Rt. 4 is a divided highway so you must exit left in the median cross-path.

BE CAREFUL when crossing left over RT. 4.

From I-275 at Route 4 – Drive north 3+ miles to the Rt. 4 by-pass. Turning right, travel approximately 8 miles to Rt. 4. Turn right on Rt. 4 and go 2+ miles to Elks golf course with entrance on left.

BE CAREFUL when crossing left over RT. 4.

From I-275 at State Route 747 (Princeton-Glendale Road) - Travel north 8.5 miles to Route 4. Turn left on Rt. 4 and go 1.3 miles to golf course with entrance on right.
